Good things are certainly happening in the global world of ISELP."

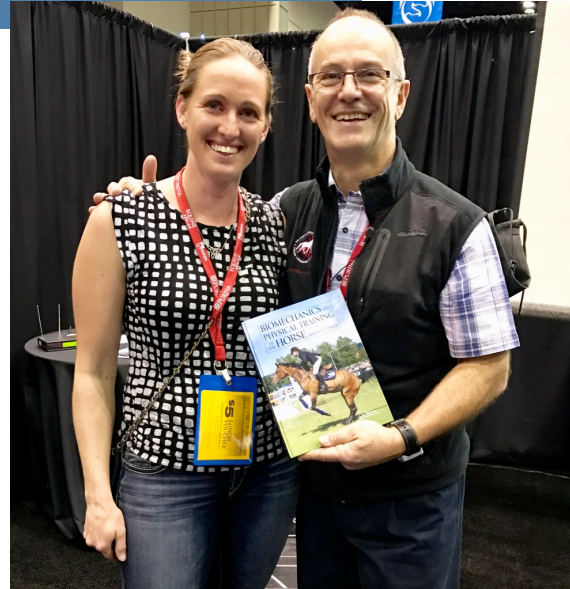

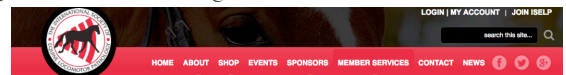
From your Administrative & Marketing Team here are a few tips to make sure you're taking full advantage of your ISELP Networking. . .

This is where you have the ability to update all of your information. Be sure to update your physical address so that you can appear on the ISELP Location Member Map.

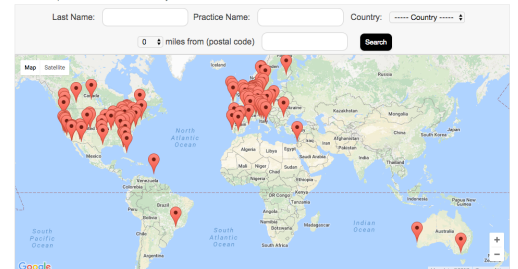
4. Photos that are updated cannot be larger than 120mb otherwise none of your information will be saved properly. This is critical.

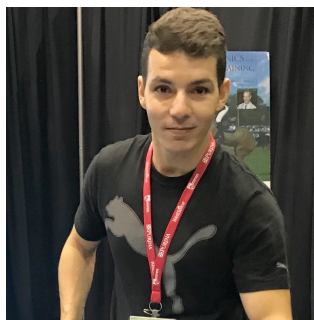
