**EQUINE ACTIVITY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT FOR WORLDWIDE  
EDUCATIONAL SEMINARS AND OR ACTIVITIES**

1. The Registered Attendee has read and understood, and freely and voluntarily entered into this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement with The International Society of Equine Locomotor Pathology and its activity host, understanding that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement is a waiver of any and all liability. Participation in this equine activity is purely voluntary, and I elect to participate in spite of and with full knowledge of the risks.
2. I understand the potential dangers that I could incur. Understanding those risks, I hereby release The International Society of Equine Locomotor Pathology and its Host, employees, volunteers, students, and anyone else directly or indirectly connected with them from any liability whatsoever in the event of injury, death or damage of any nature to me, my equipment or anyone else caused by or incidental to my electing to participate in this equine activity.
3. I understand and recognize and warrant that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement is being voluntarily and intentionally agreed to.
4. I further voluntarily agree and warrant to Release and Hold Harmless The International Society of Equine Locomotor Pathology and it's Host from any liability whatsoever, including, but not limited to, any incident caused by or related to said equine professional's negligence, relating to injuries known, unknown, or otherwise not herein disclosed, including, but not limited to, injuries, death or property damage to myself.
5. In the event of any dispute or disagreement relating in any manner whatsoever to this agreement the parties agree and consent to engage in mediation in a good faith effort to resolve the dispute amicably before either party resorts to court action.

**COVID-19 SAFETY ACKNOWLEDGEMENT -- LIABILITY WAIVER AND RELEASE  
OF CLAIMS**

***COVID-19 SAFETY INFORMATION:***

While participating in events held or sponsored by The International Society of Equine Locomotor Pathology (ISELP) "social distancing" must be practiced and face coverings worn at all times to reduce the risks of exposure to COVID-when mandated by local jurisdictions.

Because COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is spread mainly from person-to-person contact, ISELP has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19. However, ISELP cannot guarantee that its participants, volunteers, partners, or others in attendance will not become infected with COVID-19.

In light of the ongoing spread of COVID-19, individuals who fall within any of the categories below should not engage in ISELP events. By attending an ISELP event, you certify that you do not fall into any of the following categories:

1. Individuals who currently or within the past fourteen (14) days prior to the event have experienced any symptoms associated with COVID-19, which include fever, cough, and shortness of breath among others.
2. Individuals who believe that they may have been exposed to a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-

19 or have been diagnosed with COVID-19 and are not yet cleared as non-contagious by state or local public health authorities or the health care team responsible for their treatment.

***DUTY TO SELF-MONITOR:***

Participants and volunteers agree to self-monitor for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 (symptoms typically include fever, cough, and shortness of breath) and, contact ISELP if he/she experiences symptoms of COVID-19 within 14 days after participating at an ISELP event and or activity.

***LIABILITY WAIVER AND RELEASE OF CLAIMS:***

I acknowledge that I derive personal satisfaction and a benefit by virtue of my participation with ISELP, and I willingly engage in ISELP events.

***RELEASE AND WAIVER.*** I HEREBY RELEASE, WAIVE AND FOREVER DISCHARGE ANY AND ALL LIABILITY, CLAIMS, AND DEMANDS OF WHATEVER KIND OR NATURE AGAINST THE INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY OF EQUINE LOCOMOTOR PATHOLOGY AND ITS AFFILIATED PARTNERS AND SPONSORS, INCLUDING IN EACH CASE, WITHOUT LIMITATION, THEIR DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, VOLUNTEERS, AND AGENTS (THE “RELEASED PARTIES”), EITHER IN LAW OR IN EQUITY, TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMISSIBLE BY LAW, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO DAMAGES OR LOSSES CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE, FAULT OR CONDUCT OF ANY KIND ON THE PART OF THE RELEASED PARTIES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO DEATH, BODILY INJURY, ILLNESS, ECONOMIC LOSS OR OUT OF POCKET EXPENSES, OR LOSS OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY, WHICH I, MY HEIRS, ASSIGNEES, NEXT OF KIN AND/OR LEGALLY APPOINTED OR DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVES, MAY HAVE OR WHICH MAY HEREAFTER ACCRUE ON MY BEHALF, WHICH ARISE OR MAY HEREAFTER ARISE FROM MY PARTICIPATION WITH THE ACTIVITY.
